

HFCA 2017-2018 Re-enrollment Grant and Aid

TUITION FOR 2017-2018 will remain the same as this current year.

Thank you to those who completed your FACTS Grant and Aid application. For those who completed it, your 2016 tax forms have been waived, so disregard the notices.

There is still time to complete your application but you will now need to use your 2016 tax and IRS forms. The last day to apply for assistance will be February 24th. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact us.

HFCA 2017-2018 Registration

2017-2018 HFCA registration will begin on January 23, 2017. To qualify for Early Bird registration, you must be current with this year's balances. (tuition, After Care, sports, etc.) Early Bird registration allows you to receive a 50% discount on registration fees if all paperwork is completed by March 10th and all outstanding balances have been paid in full and verified through Mrs. Krasner. If you decide to add your registration to your monthly FACTS tuition payment, the Early Bird discount does not apply.
